PROGRAM AND COURSE LEARNING OBJECTIVES

This course is designed to give the general dentist a better understanding of the conditions that can result in implant prosthetic failures, with the goal of increasing long-term predictability of implant restorations in their practices. We will cover biomechanics, case planning, and long-term implant maintenance. Course goals include understanding how planning and communication can minimize complications and how to apply this in your practice, as well as how to utilize restorative techniques and digital technology that can minimize complications. We will also discuss how to identify complications before the implant is lost.

Participants attending will have a better understanding of biomechanics for single implants, managing occlusal overload and cantilevers for the single restoration, ideal implant positioning, using two implants vs. one for wider spaces, the importance of communication with the surgeon and lab, using intraoral scanners, cementless implant options, managing screw loosening and fractures, and discussion of applications of digital implant dentistry..

Dr. Hodges integrated dental implant restoration into his general practice in 2001. He continued to expand implant services in his practice while attending almost 1000 hours of implant related continuing education. In 2012 he sold his general practice and opened an office offering only dental implant services. Dr. Hodges lectures nationally for Neoss and Nobel Biocare on several subjects including full-arch prosthetics, restorative complications, and Locators. He completed the fellowship program at the California Implant Institute, has restored hundreds of fixed full-arch implant restorations, is a Nobel Biocare CAD certified technician, is a Fellow of the International Congress of Oral Implantologists, and is honored to have been selected to Seattle Metropolitan's "Top Dentists" in 2010, 2011, and 2012 by his peers.

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
